I have changed servers this weekend and now the participants of the survey receive this error when they click on the link to do the survey in the e-mail the program sends to them!:

"This is a controlled survey. You need a valid token to participate.

The message should come up if (a) the same token number is used by more than one person, or (b) if you have cookies turned on, and someone is using the same computer to try and do the survey more than once.

I'd start by turning off cookies. You don't need them in a controlled survey.

OK, sounds like you're a bit unsure about how the surveys work.

No, you don't need to use tokens. Tokens should only be used if you wish to have a controlled list of invitees on your survey. If you just want to be able to publish a URL and have lots and lots of people do the survey, you DON'T want to use tokens.

Once you turn on the tokens control, the only people who can do your survey are those who you have entered into your tokens table, with an email address, and who have had a unique token generated for them.

So, if all this is news to you, then I'd suggest your problem is that you've enabled tokens for this survey, but you really don't want them.

In the LimeSurvey admin, select the survey, then click on the picture of 3 people ("Activate/Edit Tokens for this Survey"). Once you're in there, click on the document with a big red X through it (very right hand side) "Drop Tokens Table".. then click on the button "Delete Tokens". Then return to the main admin screen. Your survey will now be available to anyone who can click on the URL.

Then you should turn cookies back on, and you should turn off "Allow Public Registration".

If, on the other hand you wanted to restrict access to your survey to just those people you invite, then you need to turn the tokens on (or leave them as they are).

No, if you don't use the tokens table, then you don't have a tokens table to send email invitations! Why did you drop the
tokens table? I thought you said yesterday that you needed to use it?

Let's try and get it very clear. If you want to `_RESTRICT_` access to your survey, then you use the tokens table. If you
want to `_OPEN_` access to your survey, then you don't use the tokens table.

If you don't use a tokens table then access to the survey is open to everybody who knows the URL. If you want to send
emails advertising the URL, you need to do that manually.

If you use a tokens table, then you restrict access to the survey only to those who you have entered into the tokens table.
There is a built in mechanism for sending emails to those you have put in the tokens table.

Well, there's nothing wrong with that! And as far as you know, the people who are having the problem haven't done the

survey before on the same computer?

I'm a bit stumped, and working out what could be going wrong with this will probably involve script debugging. We'd need to see exactly what your server is interpreting as the token value, and why it thinks that this token has already been completed.

So the email works for you, but not for the other person! That makes no sense..

When someone connects using that link, the server takes the token value from the URL, and then checks the tokens database for the entry with the same token. If that token number has already submitted a survey, then it refuses the person.. with the message you get.

But if the survey token number hasn't been used, it proceeds with the survey.
