It's a competition, judges are asked to score the performance of people in the contest, using numbers from 0 to 7:

Judge would choose a number in the drop-down list. Alternatively, the judge could type a number, instead. I would rather use the drop-down list, since the only valid choices are the numbers 0,1,2,3,4,5,6 and 7.

Thanks for replying to my post. :) I don't think that an array would help, since I would like to assess the score of each person simultaneously.:dry:

Here we are talking about a papers. There are several students and, therefore, several papers. The judge/teacher will have to evaluate the paper, scoring a 0 to 5 in, at least, 3 features. The final score would be the sum of the 3 features.

Example:A paper about history. The paper would be evaluated in 3 points:

Grammar;  
accuracy;  
Quoted Sources.

Maximum score: 15

I would rather send the survey int this fashion:
